## Immediate Response to Traumatic Events

Reactions to traumatic events vary widely, but can include extreme shock, fear, helplessness, and physical symptoms. We respond on-site after traumatic events with support and referrals, and help people identify healthy coping strategies. Our suicide prevention and postvention services offer support, consultation, and screening after a death and help communities work proactively toward prevention. We have provided emergency response and crisis management in these types of situations:

- Schools where students have died by suicide, homicide, medical causes, or accidental causes
- Communities affected by tornadoes, floods, or other natural disasters
- Violence in a school, workplace, or community
