A Comprehensive Continuum of Care for Substance Use & Co-Occurring Disorders

Riverside Community Care offers a coordinated continuum of substance use and co-occurring disorder services — spanning crisis stabilization, structured treatment, court-involved programs, and long-term recovery support. Individuals may access multiple services simultaneously and enter the system at any point.

How Our Services Connect — No Wrong Door, No Silos

Crisis Services

Immediate response, 24/7

- **Mobile Crisis Intervention (MCI): Norwood Area (800-529-5077), Milford Area (800-294-4665)**
24/7 community-based response by phone, at home, or in the community. Alternative to the emergency department for adults and youth. No insurance required.
- **Community Crisis Stabilization: Upton area (508-422-8095)**
Voluntary up to 5-day residential stabilization for adults in acute substance use or mental health crisis serving as a step-down from inpatient care. No insurance required.

Care Coordination & Recovery Supports

Breaking down barriers to treatment

- **Connect2Recovery (781-234-1650)**
C2R provides an interdisciplinary team committed to recovery — including a Recovery Support Navigator, Recovery Coach, Certified Peer Specialist, & Community Support Provider. The team coordinates care across Riverside's services and accepts referrals from all sources.
- **NC-8 Recovery Coaching: Canton, Dedham, Milton, Norwood, Walpole, Wellesley, Westwood (781-234-1650)**
Free peer recovery coaching for Norfolk County residents with substance use disorder. No insurance required.

Outpatient Treatment

Step-down care after detox or inpatient stay

- **Structured Outpatient Addiction Program: (781-246-2010 x 2014)**
Intensive virtual day treatment for substance use disorder and co-occurring conditions. Group & individual counseling, peer support, aftercare planning are available.
- **Outpatient Counseling & MAT: Newton (617-969-4925), Norwood (781-769-8670), Somerville (617-354-2275), Lynnfield (781-246-2010), Milford (508-529-7000), Cambridge (857-331-6331)**
Individual and group therapy. Medication-Assisted Treatment is available in Somerville, Milford, and Norwood.
- **Community Behavioral Health Centers: Milford area (508-529-7000), Norwood area (781-769-8670)**
CBHCs provide a full continuum of services — outpatient therapy, medication management, MAT, group therapy, peer support, care coordination, and 24/7 mobile crisis intervention, including urgent and walk-in appointments.

Court-Related Services

For justice-involved individuals

- **Behavioral Health Justice Initiative: Norfolk County (781-234-1650)**
A case management service bridging the justice and behavioral health systems for individuals pre – or post incarceration.
- **Massachusetts Impaired Driving Program: Lynnfield (781-246-2010)**
16-week court-mandated virtual program for first DUI offenders. Satisfies probation requirements.
- **Second Offender Aftercare & Court Ordered Substance Use Evaluations: Lynnfield (781-246-2010)**
Year-long outpatient treatment for second DUI offenders featuring clinical evaluations and compliance support for drug court.
